

Magento 2 - Inventory Log

Overview

- Keep a log of product inventory for every transaction, including product imports, orders placed, and insert/update operations through database queries.
- Administrators can identify when and why inventory changed.
- The extension keeps an inventory log for the following events:
 - Orders placed from the frontend, admin and API.
 - Product imports.
 - Manual product inventory changes by an administrator.
 - Direct inventory insert/update operations in the database.
 - Products created using the API.
 - Credit Memo generation.
 - Order failure and cancellation.

Installation

- 1 Download the latest Inventory Log extension from [here](#).
- 2 Download the module package and extract it.
- 3 Copy the extracted files to `app/code/KiwiCommerce/KiwiCommerce_InventoryLog`.

After installing the extension, run the following commands:

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
php bin/magento cache:flush
```

Features

Navigate to Products > Catalog

Navigate to **Products > Catalog** and click the **Edit** link for the required product.

Product Inventory Log Grid

Click the **Inventory Log** link to view the inventory log grid for the respective product.

Configuration

Follow this path: **Stores > Configuration > KIWICOMMERCE EXTENSIONS > Inventory Log**.

Constraints

- The database user must have permission to create triggers in order to use this extension.
- After enabling a previously disabled extension using the command line, the administrator/user will need to enable the extension again from the store configuration.
